## Mr. Keizo Takemi

### Visiting Professor

Member of the House of Councillors Chairperson, LDP Policy Board in the House of Councillors Former Deputy Minister of Health, Labour and Welfare Division

Born November 5, 1951 in Minato-ku, Tokyo. He graduated in Political Science from Keio University School of Law in 1974 and then from the university's Graduate School of Law in 1976. He was appointed Political Science research associate at Tokai University School of Political Science and Economics in 1980; associate professor in 1987; professor in 1995; and in the same year, he won his first election to the General Assembly of Party Members of the House of Councillors where he is now in his fourth term.

From 1984 to 1987, he was news anchor for TV Asahi CNN Day Watch, Morning Show, whilst in political affairs, he held the positions of Foreign Affairs Minister of Foreign Affairs, Chairperson of the House of Councillors for Diplomatic Defense, Deputy Director of the Health, Labor and Welfare Committee and Deputy Minister of Health and Labor. He was a member of the United Nations System Reform Committee under the Secretary-General of the United Nations; a committee member for maternal and child health improvement; a member of the World Health Organization (WHO) Research and Development Fund Expert Committee; and a postdoctoral fellow at Harvard University School of Public Health from 2007 to 2009.

Currently, he is Chairperson of the LDP Policy Board in the House of Councillors; Chairperson of the Special Mission Committee on International Health and Medical Strategy; and Senior Fellow of the Japan International Exchange Center. Mr. Takemi who is a visiting professor at Nagasaki University and Keio University School of Medicine will talk about UHC and how Nagasaki University can contribute.

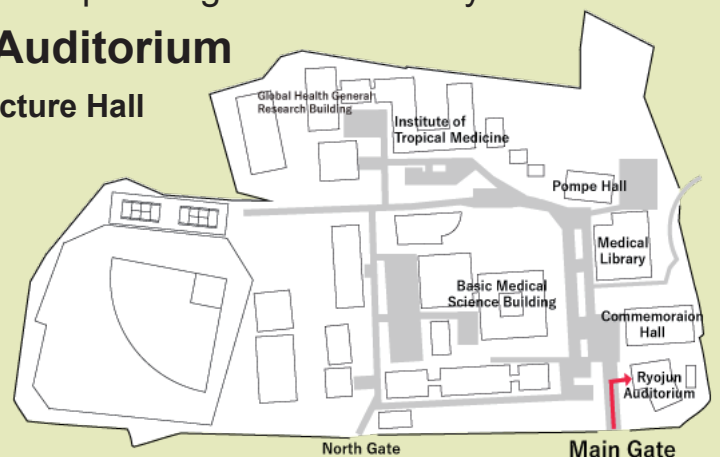
